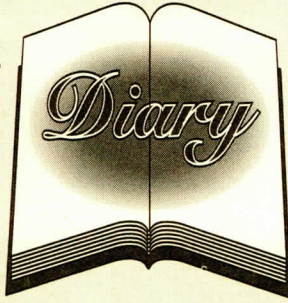

# Sunway strengthens VicUni ties with MoU

**S**UNWAY College renewed its partnership with Victoria University (VicUni) of Australia recently with the signing of a new memorandum of understanding paving the way for fresh commitments in the fields of teaching, research and staff development.

Sunway College principal Elizabeth Lee, who signed the agreement with VicUni's Vice-Chancellor and President Professor Jarlath Ronayne said the new agreement would provide the teaching staff with new opportunities to work on co-operative projects and research.

The agreement provides provisions for the appointment of a Research Co-ordinator, the development of a Research Management Plan and the implementation of a series of joint research projects to be funded by the respective institutions.

VicUni has also agreed to admit up to five Sunway staff to pursue postgraduate and PhD programmes over the next two years and exempt them from paying fees, besides offering seven faculty scholarships.

VicUni is also offering seven student undergraduate faculty scholarships this year and the next, said Lee.

Sunway's partnership with VicUni began six years ago when 45 students enrolled in its programmes.

Now, 500 students are taking its programmes and majoring in Multimedia, Information Technology and Business, besides a newly-introduced Marketing and International Tourism programme.
