*Debate*, held two days ago, also featured local debating "stars" from Universiti Malaya and the International Islamic University of Malaysia.

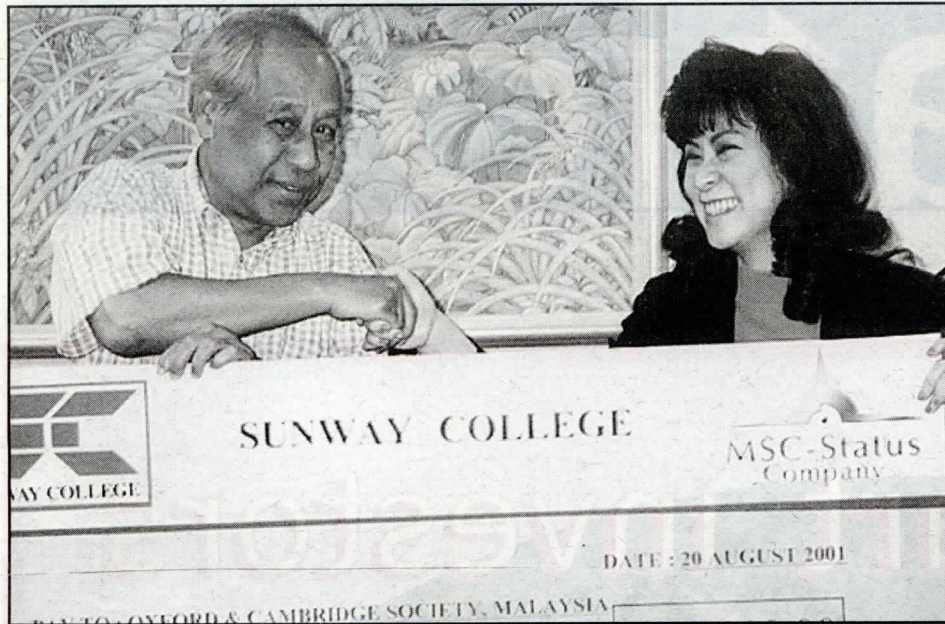
Organised by the Oxford and Cambridge Society of Malaysia, the debate was aimed at promoting a healthy debating activity among higher education institutions in the country.
