

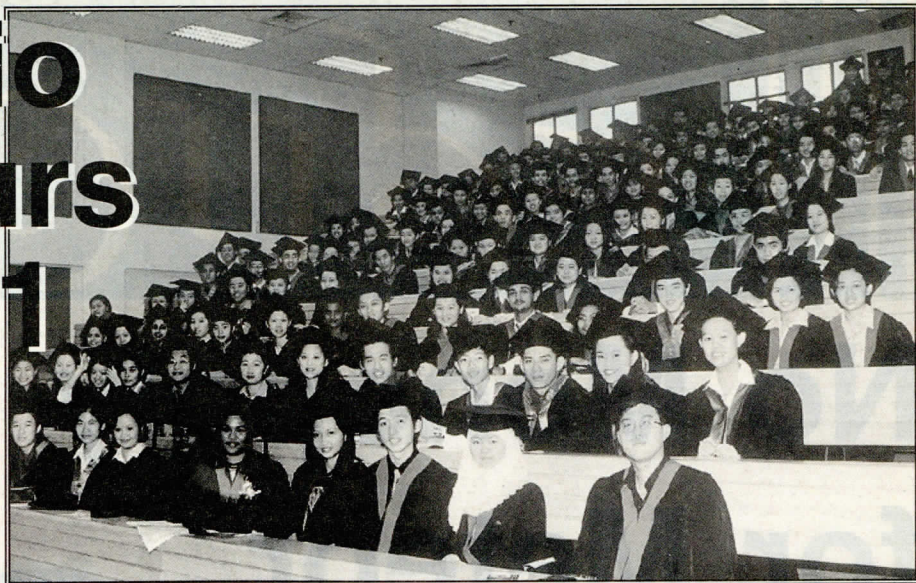
# Ontario honours for 171

ONE hundred and seventy-one students received their Ontario Secondary School Diplomas (OSSD) at the 17th graduation ceremony of the Sunway College-Canadian International Matriculation Programme (CIMP) recently.
