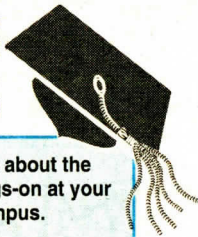

The group were the pioneer batch of participants of a unique programme organised through arrangements between CICPA, the Malaysian Institute of Accountants and Sunway College.
