

For a career in hospitality management



Hands-on training for the Sunway Hospitality Management students.

Business forecasts predict that hospitality will be one of the largest businesses in Malaysia and the world. In line with Malaysia's vision of becoming a major tourist destination, Sunway College set up a School of Hospitality Management two years ago to train qualified personnel for the industry.

At Sunway, students will like the conducive environment complete with sports facilities, on-campus hostel accommodation, spacious

parking, *surau*, a well-stocked bookshop, a convenience store, launderette and 24-hour security services.

The School of Hospitality Management students have access to the most comprehensive and advanced facilities: state-of-the-art library, well-equipped computer laboratories, air-conditioned classrooms and lecture theatres.

They also receive guidance from experienced lecturers. "They will be trained by highly skilled and experienced academic staff," says Mae Tan,

director of School of Hospitality Management. "Six of our 15 staff have a Masters degree." And they are supplemented by top visiting experts from the hotel industry.

Tan says a holistic approach is taken to develop all-rounded students.

F&B lecturer Ellis Lee concurs. "We need to make them want to know things. We send them to do research at cafes and bring back their

experience."

The Diploma in Hotel & Catering Management offered at Sunway College, says Tan, has equal emphasis on skills and management of a hospitality organisation and prepares students to be multi-skilled in both supervisory and managerial positions.

They learn about front office management, wines & beverages, culinary arts, hotel administration, restau-

rant & fine dining and professional housekeeping.

Students study for six semesters (two years) with four months of supervised work experience. Credits are recognised for advanced level to universities in the UK, the US, Canada, Australia, Switzerland and France.

The whole diploma only costs about RM17,000. Scholarship may be awarded to deserving students.

Other courses offered include Certificate in Hotel & Catering Operations and City & Guilds International - Culinary Arts Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma.

After graduation, students have the opportunity to receive hands-on-training in the SungeiWay Group's luxurious hotels as well as other leisure related environments, such as Sunway Lagoon Theme Park, Sunway Pyramid and The Sunway Lagoon Club.

The next intake for the course is in January next year.
