

# Sunway students to spend only final year in Australia

**SUNWAY COLLEGE** students will only have to spend their final year at Australian universities from next year instead of the current two years.

Under its Save-The-Ringgit programme, the college has made arrangements for Monash University, Flinders University and the Victoria University of Technology to allow students to study two years at Sunway College and then complete their final year at their universities.

Sunway College vice-principal Elizabeth Lee said it is in line with the Government's appeal for students to do their tertiary education locally and save on foreign exchange.

Lee said alternatively, students also have the option to undertake a wide range of certificate, diploma and degree courses at Sunway College.

One such example is the UK National Computing Centre (NCC) three-year programme where upon completion, a student will hold a BSc (Hons) in Computing and Information Systems from London Guildhall University.

At the end of their third and final year, students will sit for the NCC graduate diploma examinations which is converted into a BSc (Hons) Degree in Computing and Information Systems from London Guildhall University.

The tuition fees for this programme are RM5,000, RM7,000 and RM13,000 for the first, second and third year respectively.

For students who want to pursue courses in Information Technology, Sunway College also offers basic certificate courses in IT for school-leavers.

These range from 10-14 hour courses to nine-month programmes with tuition fees ranging between RM600 to RM2,300. - *By V. VASUDEVAN*
