A less stressful pre-university programme

PRE-UNIVERSITY programmes which assess students continuously through project work and assignments are the choice of students who find it too stressful to depend solely on a single examination.

One such programme is the Canadian Matriculation Programme offered at Sunway College.

Identical to the one offered at secondary schools in Ontario, Canada the programme awards students a diploma which allows them entry into universities worldwide.

It is a student-centered programme which emphasises on continuous evaluation of the students' progress through assignments, projects and coursework which carry substantial weight in the total accumulated points for the subjects taken.

Of course, there is still the final examination which carries some points.

Those with Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia usually take up six pre-university or Ontario Academic Courses which upon completion in two semesters, will get them the Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

The diploma is recog-

nised by most major universities and students have used it to enrol into universities in Australia, the United Kingdom, United States and New Zealand.

Many students have also used the qualification to pursue twinning courses at Sunway or gain entry into Monash University's Sunway Campus.

Students who do not qualify for entry into the available pre-university programmes can enter into the three-semester Pre-OAC foundation programme to prepare them for entry into the OAC programme.

The programme also offers a multitude of extra-curricular activities, ranging from the student newspaper to debating and sport activities.

The combination of an excellent programme and the good study environment and student support allows them to do well in their studies.

There are two intakes a year, in January and in July. The next intake is on Jan 6.
