

# Sunway scholarships

When the president of Zimbabwe last visited Malaysia, Tan Sri Dr Jeffrey Cheah, founder of Sunway College, offered scholarships as a gesture of goodwill to strengthen the relationship between Malaysia and Zimbabwe.

University bursaries for a five-year period were pledged to five Zimbabwean students. They are Nomusa H. Subanda, Bengan S. Manwere, Sudden Macheyo, Nqobani

Ngwenya, and Onias Gweru.

These students, who are currently studying at the Sunway College-Victoria University of Technology twinning programme, are pursuing a degree in business.

The scholarship includes tuition fees, textbooks, hostel accommodation and airfares, and it amounts to approximately RM 100,000 for the fine.
