The month-long "Heart to Heart Sunway College Community Project" ended recently with a cheque presentation ceremony to nine welfare homes from around the Klang Valley by Datin Seri Ena Ling.

The college managed to raise RM 26,000 for the benefit of non-governmental children's homes such as Rumah Charis, Rumah Hope, Rumah Kebajikan Good Shepherd, Shelter, Rumah Sayangan, Rumah Ozanam, Rumah Care, Pure Life Society and Sunbeams Home.

Awards were also given to Marianne Francis Chia from the Western Michigan University (WMU) programme, Jorainagal Wong from the Canadian Matriculation Programme (CMP) and course mate Yap Phui Ling who were among the

top three fund-raisers for the event.

The drive involved more than 600 students and staff who distributed over 900 donation cards, organised a food sale and ran a blood donation campaign and car wash throughout the month.

An exhibition was also set up to provide public education on children's needs and to create awareness of society's responsibilities towards the underprivileged.

According to the college's vice principal Elizabeth Soo, the community project is an annual event to expose the students to those less fortunate than them.
