HARVARD and Radcliffe Colleges (the undergraduate schools of Harvard University) associate director of Financial Aid and Senior Admissions officer, Janet Irons, was on a recent promotional visit to the region.

Hosted by the Harvard Club of Malaysia, Irons, who is responsible for applications for Asia, was at the Sunway College to discuss "Undergraduate Education in the USA".

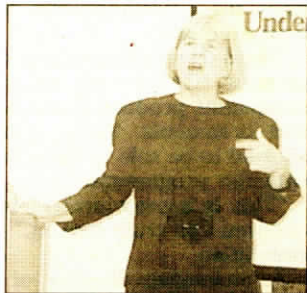
She said that at present, there are fewer than 10 Malaysian students pursuing their undergraduate studies at Harvard College.

"If you are admitted but cannot afford it, chances are you will be sponsored by the University. Bringing together people from different backgrounds is what edu-

cation is all about," she said.

Harvard consists of 15 different schools offering Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science undergraduate programmes.

Harvard, established in 1636, is located in Boston and has 50 different colleges. The University has a population of 6,500 undergraduates and its library is recognised as the largest of its kind in the world.
