

ACADEMIC WRITING: English teachers at the workshop conducted by da Silva Rosa

English workshop for Sunway College teachers

VISITING lecturer from University of Western Australia, Catherine da Silva Rosa, recently conducted an English language workshop at Sunway College.

She focused on common difficulties faced by students in writing academic English when they entered universities.

She gave a brief review on expectations academics have of students in Australian universities, analysis on the writings of accountancy and finance students at the university, and what constituted 'good' academic writing.

The workshop was run for English teachers from the college's various programmes like Western Michigan University, Canadian Matriculation and Western Australian Matriculation, and the Language Department.
