English books for school in China

SUNWAY College is sending books to China on a voluntary basis to help students in a secondary school and a kindergarten there to improve their English.

This project was prompted after a recent visit by three of the college's teachers to Xian who found a dearth of English re-

source materials at the Tai Yi Middle School and the private kindergarten.

The secondary school students will receive 26 novels by Charles Dickens, George Orwell, Agatha Christie and others whilst the kindergarten children will get books by well-known children's

writers.

A spokesperson for the college said the Chinese student's enthusiasm to learn English despite the fact that they were particularly handicapped by limited learning resources has made the visits to the school very memorable.
