

Special route to a degree course

SUNWAY College will launch a three-year "special degree route programme" for SPM, "O" level and MICSS students leading to an honours degree in computing and information systems from the London Guildhall

University. The programme is being offered from next month under special arrangements with Britain's National Computing Centre (NCC).

Students can do their studies at Sunway College

and spend only two weeks at the London Guildhall University. Those who did not have the four credits requirement in the SPM, "O" level or MICSS can still apply but are subjected to a qualifying test.

With the completion of their third year, students can find jobs in project management and software engineering.

The NCC is now developing a Master's degree course.
