Award of scholarship

WESTERN Michigan University presented Lee Kwok Ching with a scholarship award worth US\$750 (RM2,015) in a ceremony attended by students and lecturers recently at Sunway College in Bandar Sunway.

Lee, a second year electrical engineering student, received the award from Dr Diether Haenicke, president of Western Michigan University at Kalamazoo.

After 16 months at the local campus, Lee will complete the remaining 28 months of the four-year

course in the American university.

Lee managed to attain better results than the others in his transfer group with an Acquired Grade Point Average of 3.64 to win the scholarship.

Seventy-eight students from Sunway College have been admitted to the Western Michigan University.

Lee, who is the elder of two, will leave for Kalamazoo in December. Meanwhile he is residing at the campus hostel.

Lee said his uncle, who is

an accountant with the Sungei Way Group, influenced and encouraged him to enrol for the degree course at Western Michigan University.

Lee wants to obtain a double degree, possibly majoring in computer systems engineering to be followed by a masters.
