## Student moved to help after visiting cancer centre

A VISIT to a cancer centre opened the eyes of Sunway College students and teachers to the sufferings of the patients.

So much so that it fired up a student to single-handedly raise RM2,000 for cancer treatment in conjunction with the Terry Fox Run recently.

Her contribution made up almost a quarter of the total collection of RM8,342 made by 60 participants from the college.

"After the visit, I realised how awful cancer can be. I don't want anyone I know to suffer from it and I worked hard to get pledges for the purchase of the Stereotatic Mammography Machine", said the student, who declined to be named.

The college visitors were taken to the Cancer Research and Diagnostic Centre of the National Cancer Society before participating in the run at Taman Tasek Perdana recently.

College representative Kenneth Leong presented a cheque for RM8,342 to Regent Hotel general manager Christoph Schmidinger. The hotel is involved in the project.
