45 awarded Aussie degrees

THE University of Western Australia (UWA) conferred degrees on 45 graduates of its twinning programmes with Malaysian colleges last Saturday at the Australian High Commission.

Seventeen were graduates from Sunway College with two in Masters and one Singapore student.
